What are three main points that the clergy should know about this subject?

- Clergy, teachers, and teacher's aides are mandated reporters of child abuse and elder/dependent adult abuse
- Reasonable suspicion of abuse triggers the duty to report
- There is no requirement to report when the information is obtained in a "penitential communication"

What are three ways in which clergy can help their congregants?

- Provide safe environment training to all staff
- Include safe environment resource information on the congregation website and bulletin boards
- Incorporate age appropriate safe environment materials in religious education curricula for children
